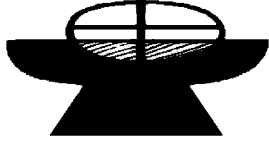

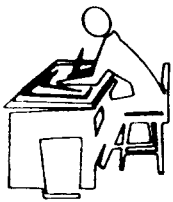
Celebration of St. John Vianney, Our Patron Saint
